

## PROF ROLAND SCHULZE

Roland Schulze (PhD, University of Natal), is a Fellow of the Royal Society of South Africa and Member of the Academy of Science of South Africa.

Retired as Professor of Hydrology at the University of KwaZulu-Natal, he is now a Senior Research Associate at that University and a mentor / consultant to Government and the South African and international water and agricultural industries. Originally a hydrological model developer, his main focus nowadays is on climate change issues (vulnerability, impacts, adaptation as well as policy) in the agriculture and water sectors.

In the climate change field he has lead numerous multi-institutional research projects with national and international funding. He recently completed a 672 page "Handbook for Farmers, Officials and Others on the Adaptation to Climate Change in the South African Agriculture Sector". Author of over 500 scientific publications, he also has wide international lecturing and collaborative research experience. Prof Schulze until recently served on the Minister's National Water Advisory Council.
