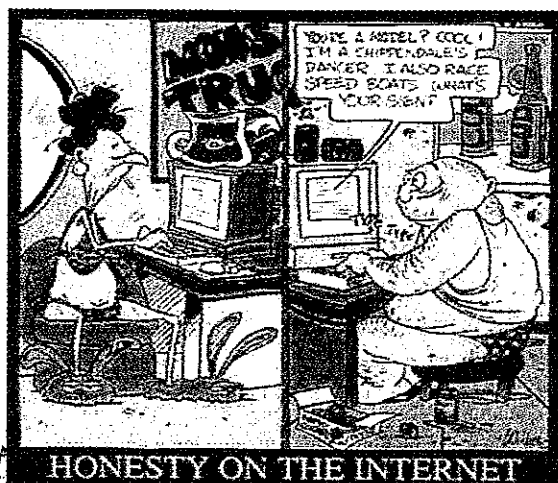

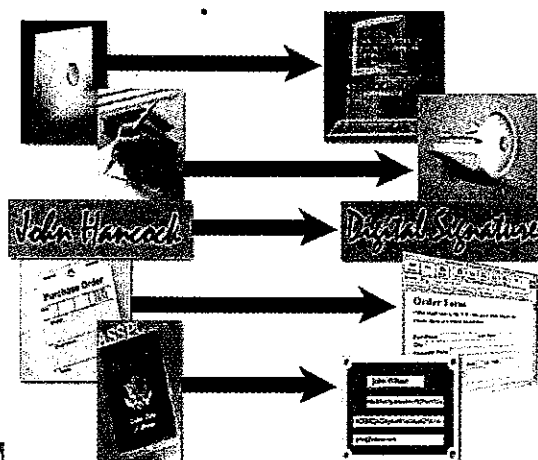

- Normal Business

## Where to start

- High-level buy-in
- Understand the customer/supplier/trading partner requirements
- Decide on a pilot – 80/20 principle
- Select a technology partner or service provider
- Ensure that the authentication and security framework is in place

- Integrate solution into back-office systems

  - Call centre

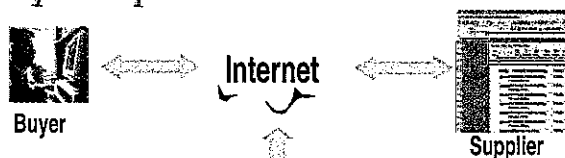
