

Prof Ferdi Meyer

Ferdi grew up on a crop and livestock farm in the North-West Province of South Africa. He completed a PhD degree in Agricultural Economics at the University of Pretoria in 2006 following a study abroad programme at the University of Missouri, United States. He was one of the founding members of the Bureau for Food and Agricultural Policy (BFAP) in 2004. Following his 20-year career at the University of Pretoria as associate professor, he took on the position as managing director of BFAP. BFAP is internationally recognised as an independent think tank on the African continent, serving the agro-food, fibre and beverage sectors. Ferdi has been leading the team on a vast range of national and international strategic projects and initiatives. These include the National Development Plan and the Agricultural and Agro-processing Master Plan for South Africa, strategic sector and investment analyses for a number of private sector firms, and end-to-end value chain projects in a number of Eastern and Southern African countries. He specialises in agricultural market, trade - and policy analyses, value chain analytics, strategic foresighting and scenario planning. In June 2020, he was appointed as Professor Extraordinary in the Department of Agricultural Economics at the University of Stellenbosch.
